Italian Montepulciano: A medium-bodied red with a clean finish. Drinks well & pairs with a variety of foods.

Italian Sangiovese: A light, easy-drinking red with hints of tartness & a balanced acidity that pairs it well with foods.



Italian Amarone: A bold, deep red wine with a sweet, long finish.

Chianti: A light to medium-bodied red with rounded oak and a smooth finish.



Barolo: A medium-bodied red with strong deep fruit notes and a smooth, balanced finish.

Sicilian Nero D'Avola/Shiraz: Medium to full-bodied blend with nice oak character and a spicy finish.



Italian Pinot Grigio: Light, easy-drinking white, crisp with notes of citrus.

Luna Bianca: Full-bodied white blend, heavy oak character with a fruity-sweet finish.
